

New Executive for TSA



A new Executive team was voted in at the Annual General Meeting held in Perth during the current Australian Seniors Championships.

Reg Trevaskis, previously Treasurer, is the new President. Reg is a resident of Brisbane but plays much of his tennis at the Gold Coast Seniors Club. He hails originally from South Africa but has been in Australia now for 26 years. Reg has Bachelor of Commerce and Master of Business Administration degrees and is a past Fellow of the Australian Institute of Management, but has been retired for 6 years.

The new Vice President is Enid Besant-Ryan. Enid is a previous President of Tennis Seniors NSW (3 years) and has been an active seniors tennis participant for 16 years. She works in Canberra as an International HR Administrator.

Treasurer Peter Froelich is a qualified Accountant and Tax Agent (B Comm, FCPA) Peter is a former Seniors World number 1, and has now represented Australia 18 times. Peter resides on the Gold Coast and is well known to many of our members as he is a regular participant in tournaments around the country.

Secretary Pat Moloney, like Enid, is a resident of Canberra and is also the current President of Tennis Seniors ACT. Pat is a retired qualified engineer and also has a Diploma in Fitness.

Yvonne Stanton has retained her role as Competition and Events Manager on the TSA Executive. Yvonne lives in Sydney where she works as an Overseas Logistics Manager with an importing company. She has been on the TSNSW Committee for 3 years and has previously been the President of the Strathfield Recreation Centre.

Reg has commented that there are many challenges facing TSA at present, and any member of the Executive would welcome comments or ideas from senior players – the contact details of the new Executive will shortly be posted on the website. Some of the issues about which they would be happy to receive comment include how to address declining membership and participation levels, increase social play opportunities, whether to spilt the Australian Teams Carnival from the Individual Championships, and whether to reduce the potential amount of tennis to be played in the Teams Event by, for example, playing short sets.
