

## Six Championships from Twenty for the Aussies

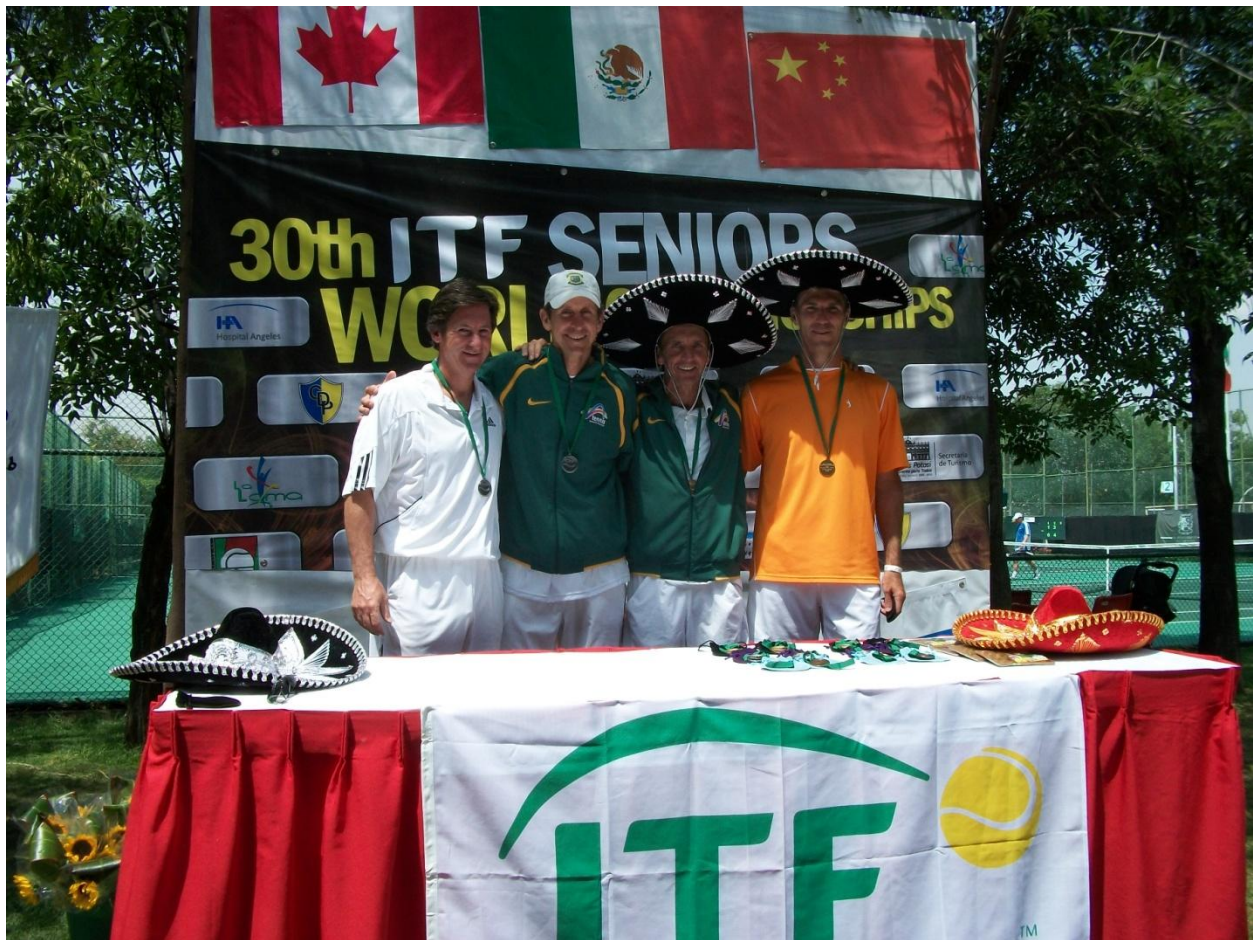

Lyn Mortimer, with Carolyn Nichols in the Doubles, defeated the fancied #1 pair, USA's Tina Karwasky and Mary Ginnard, 64 16 62. Well done, Lyn. Another lady winner was QLD's Kym Ireland who won three out of three to take the 45Women's Consolation Singles. Great work, Kym!

Paul Kleverlaan and Chris O'Mara , in the 40 Doubles, after defeating the #1 seeds, took the title against the #2 seeds, Germany's Christopher Bloemeke and USA's Morgan Shepherd, in a convincing manner, 64 64. In the Final of the 45MD, Simon Arms and Manuel Radic prevailed over Steve Casey and Canadian Denis Dumas, to take the title in a thriller, 62 46 75.

In the 50MD, Bruce Osborne and Glenn Busby, seeded #2, have been defeated in the Semi-final, by the in-form USA pair, Ross Persons and Michael Tammen in straight sets. In the 55s, our #1 seeded pair of Andrew Rae and Gary Thoroughgood have had success in the Final, where they beat the #4 seeds, USA's Fred Robinson and Tom Smith, 60 76 (8). Now that could easily have gone to three sets! Well done, guys to win it in two!

In the 50MS Semi-final, Glenn Busby defeated #3 seed, Mike Fedderly (USA) in a nail-biter, 26 64 62, and then went on to beat #2 seed, Pierre Godfroid in the Final, 62 10 ret. The shock of the tournament has occurred in the 55MS where our very popular #1 seed Andrew Rae, has been defeated in the Final by #5 seed, Dan Waldman (USA) 64 76, a great win for Dan who had to beat the #2 seed Roger Guedes in the quarters, (in 3 sets) and #7 seed Paul French in 3 sets in the Semi-final.
